



Defensive Driving Course Registration

Operators of university motorized vehicles and equipment are **required** to have a current driver's license **and** a BYU-Idaho Driving Permit. You are **not allowed** to drive a university vehicle until you obtain a BYU-Idaho Driving Permit issued by Fleet Services. Only **BYUI Employees** are allowed to drive university vehicles and obtain a driving permit issued through Fleet Services.

Before a driving permit can be issued you must take the online Defensive Driving course. After taking the Defensive Driving Course, you may also be required to take additional testing if the vehicle you drive is a pickup truck, 12-passenger van, 1-ton dump truck, trailer, box truck, or utility vehicle.
