See page 405 in the LDS hymnal for information about the meter of hymn texts. Selected texts will be forwarded to composition students who will create a tune and harmonization for the text. It is also possible to submit additional original verses to public domain texts that already exist in the hymnal. If desired, the new submitted hymn text can also be sung to an existing LDS hymn tune that is in the public domain.

Please note that due to the volume of entries, not all submitted texts can be used in the Festival. We also reserve the right to make minor editorial emendations to submitted material to facilitate the flow of text with music. The poets and composers whose work is selected for the festival retain the copyright for their creations.

Any submissions to be considered for next year's festival are due no later than Monday, November 7, 2022. Please include the following with your submission: your name, address, e-mail address, phone number, and two scriptural references that support the text (such as are provided for each hymn in the LDS hymnal).


