

Pre-Chiropractic Prerequisites Requirements

Every school has different requirements. These are the most common classes that schools will require. Many Chiropractic schools do not have specific requirements, but instead, require a certain number of credits from the following prerequisites list. For example, they may require 24 credits of science and accept any of the Biology, Chemistry, or Physics courses listed below toward those 24 credits. Other chiropractic schools have specific requirements. It is very important to review the requirements for the schools you are considering. Students generally need to complete 90 semester hours of coursework. A bachelor's degree may not be required, but we recommend you complete one.
