We expect you to look sharp, modest, and uphold the highest standards of the CES Honor Code and Dress and Grooming Principles and Expectations. *Shorts, hats, and graphic tees/tanks are not permitted on tour.* <u>Exception:</u> you may wear shorts/hats on Sunday, Monday at the waterpark only, and Thursday to Thanksgiving Point onlyHair should be neat and trimmed. Men should be clean shaven. Facial and body piercings are not permitted, men may not wear earrings.

Luggage: We will be traveling by coach bus. You may bring 1 suitcase and 1 personal item.

Performance Attire: costumes, shoes, and accessories should be packed in your costume bag
