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**Technical Rider | Sound Alliance & Vocal Union**April 2022

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*The following information outlines the technical requirements of BYU-Idaho Sound Alliance and Vocal Union performances. We appreciate the assistance of the facility management in providing the best your facility can offer.*

**Stage:** We recommend a minimum stage of 36 feet wide by 24 feet deep. We are bringing most staging needs except the items below, which we will need from the venue (please note that we can adjust to most locations):

- Six armless chairs suitable for musicians playing saxophones
- One 8-foot portable table for use by front of house mixing engineers

**Lighting:** If lighting is available at the performance locations it will greatly enhance the show. We will **not** be traveling with a lighting system, The lighting needs for the show would consist of a general wash. A general wash includes red, green, blue, and amber lights usually focused to cover the performance area. Special lighting needs might include spotlights if they are available.

**Sound:** We travel with our own sound system. If a house system is available we may opt to send a stereo feed into it was well, especially in venues with balconies.

**Telex System:** We will be traveling with a Wireless Telex System for communication between the stage and the technical director. If there is a house system available for communication we may use it as well.

**Risers:** If the following 4x8 foot platforms are available, they may assist with staging, depending on the size of the stage:

- Three 24 inch tall, 4x8 foot risers
- Five 16 inch tall, 4x8 foot risers

If platforms are not available, they are not necessary and we will use travel stools which we will be bringing. The decision on whether or not to use platforms will be made when we arrive at the venue. If platforms are available and can be used, please do not set them up but just have them ready to be set up.

**Grand Piano:** If a grand piano is available we may possibly use it depending on the size of the stage and how well in tune the piano is. A grand piano is not necessary and going to extra effort or expense to have one, or tune one, is not necessary. We will bring a digital piano which will fill our needs if no grand piano is available.

**Power:** A minimum of two, 110-volt, grounded outlets as close to the stage as possible are necessary to power our sound system.

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
