

TypeFocus™ is an assessment used worldwide to help students discover their individual personality type and learn how it determines their “fit” within different careers or fields of study.

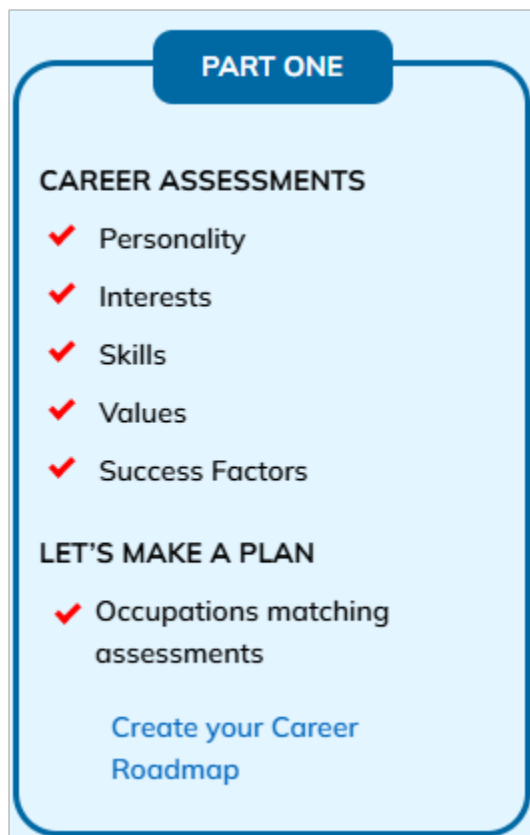

GUIDE TO TYPEFOCUS™

Step1: Self-Assessments.

Personality – Your results will reveal a four-letter personality type with a brief description of each type as well as a summary of career paths that best “fit” your natural personality strengths.

Interests – Your results will provide three occupation areas that best match your expressed interests.

Values – Based on your assessment, the results will reveal three values that are most important to you.

Skills – Based on your choices, the program will select occupations that match your skills.

Success Factors – This shows you what your score in each category says about you, including recommendations that might help you prepare for academic and career success.

Step 2: Save Occupations and Majors that you find Appealing.

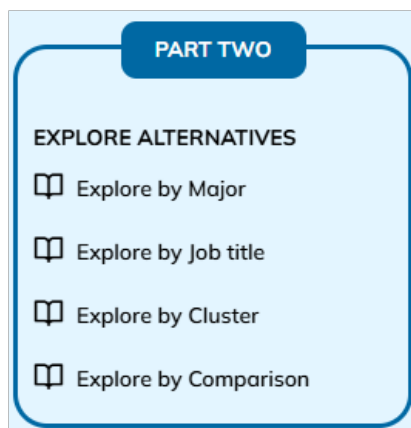
