YOUR BASIC PROFILE INFORMATION:

- Profile Photo & Cover Photo
- Professional Tagline
 - Ex: "Marketing student showcasing my skills and actively seeking employment opportunities."
- Upload Your Resume
 - Your profile will actually fill itself out based on the information on your resume
- Introduction
 - A summary of who you are, what makes you special and where you're headed
- Education (school, major, courses, degrees, clubs)
- Link to your Social Media Profiles

How is Portfolium Different?





