

Packing List – Chamber Orchestra

In choosing your clothing, we remind you that you will be representing the university. We expect you to look sharp and be modest. You will be expected to dress better than your average "classroom dress." Do not wear clothing that is tight or form-fitting. We require dress or khaki style pants that have a medium to loose fit. Jeans, shorts, graphic tees are not permitted on tour.

We will be flying on Southwest: each checked bag can weigh 50 pounds or less and be 62 inches in size (length + width + height). Bags over 50 lbs will be charged a fee at your expense. If you are carrying an instrument on the plane, it will be considered your "carry on" and must fit in the overhead bin. If it is too large to fit in the overhead bin, it will need to be loaded on the freight truck at 10 am on Wednesday, April 5.
