**BYU-Idaho 2024 Sacred Music Series: That They Might Have Joy**

REXBURG, ID – BYU-Idaho invites you to their performances of *That They Might Have Joy*, a new Sacred Music Series work. Featuring more than 300 student performers, this original work was commissioned by BYU-Idaho and written by renowned composer, Dr. Ethan Wickman. This newest Sacred Music Series will be performed by the BYU-Idaho Symphony Orchestra, Concert Choir, Bella Voce, Men's Chorus, and Women's Chorus.

"A composer of facility and imagination, the kind to whom both performers and audiences respond" (The New York Times), Ethan Wickman's music has been performed in venues around the world. Wickman was awarded the Jacob Druckman prize at the Aspen Music Festival, first place in the Utah Arts Festival Chamber Commission Competition, and was a finalist in the 25th ASCAP Rudolf Nissim Orchestral Composition Competition, as well as a finalist for the American Prize.

Wickman is currently a professor of composition and theory at the University of Texas at San Antonio.
