If desired, the new submitted hymn text can also be sung to an existing LDS hymn tune that is in the public domain.

Please note that due to the volume of entries, not all submitted texts can be used in the Festival. We also reserve the right to make minor editorial emendations to submitted material to facilitate the flow of text with music. The poets and composers whose work is selected for the festival retain the copyright for their creations.

Any submissions to be considered for next year's festival are due no later than Monday, October 12, 2020. Please include the following with your submission: your name, address, e-mail address, phone number, and two scriptural references that support the text (such as are provided for each hymn in the LDS hymnal).




