fulfill those requirements, consider taking the ALEKS (Math and Science) or Basic
Writing Exam (English) instead

-Basic Writing Exam- Choose "English 106 Test-out Exam" to begin the exam

grades. It will be accessible to you the week prior to the start of the semester
