

How To Install Kurzweil

Windows Tutorial - Transcript

Introduction

In this video, I will be showing you how to install Kurzweil onto your Windows desktop or laptop computer. Let's get started!

Step 1 - Opening and Beginning the Installation

1. Find the Kurzweil Download

- To install Kurzweil on your windows computer
- find the file that you downloaded from the Kurzweil website.
- In this case, I have that file in my downloads folder.

2. Open your File Explorer

- To open the downloads folder,
- **Click** on the folder icon on your taskbar.

3. Open the "Downloads" Folder

- Once the file explorer opens, in the top left corner, you will see the word "Downloads".
- **Click** this folder and your downloaded files will appear.

4. Find the Kurzweil File in File Explorer

- The File name for Kurzweil will have the title:
- "K3000" then "k3" followed by the version number (which in this case, is 1416). This will be followed by a "W" and then the words, "Web License.exe".

5. Open the Installation Window

- When you have found the right Kurzweil file...
- **Double Click** it, and the installation window will open.

6. Begin First Phase of Installation

- When this window opens, **Click** once on the "Browse" button.
- This will open another window that will have different folder options.
- **Click** once on the folder that says "Computer".

If you are using a laptop, this could also be labeled “This PC”, “My PC”, or “*your name* PC”. (Cover Text).

- Clicking this option will show more folder options. Now **Click** once on the option that says “Windows (C:)”. This will open your C Drive, showing more folder options.
- **Click** once on the option that says, “Program Files (x86)”.
- After selecting this, **Click** the “Ok” button. This will take you back to the first installation window.
- When you are ready, **Click** once on the “Install” button, and the first phase of the installation will begin.

Step 2 - Phase 2 of the Installation

1. Begin the Second Phase

- After this first phase is completed , another window will pop up.
- **Click** once on the button that says “Install Web Licensing Software”.
- Once you do this, the second phase of the installation will begin.
- After this second progress window is through, another window will pop up.
- **Click** on the button that says “Next”.

3. Accept the Terms

- In the next window **Click** to accept the terms.
- Then **Click** the “Next” button.

5. Give Your User Information

In the next window, it will ask you for a user name and an organization.

- In the username field **Type** in your name.
- In the organization field **Type** in BYU-Idaho.
- When you are ready, **Click** the “Next” button.

7. Install the Complete Version of Kurzweil

When the next window opens

- **Click** to install the “Complete” version of Kurzweil.
- Then **Click** the “Next” button.
- In the next window, **Click** the “Install” button and the final phase will begin.

Step 3 - The Final Phase of the Installation

1. Begin the Final Phase of the Installation

This phase can take about 5-10 minutes depending on your computer speed. Also be aware that a few black boxes will randomly pop up during this phase, don't worry, this is part of the installation.

2. Finish the Installation

Once the progress bar finishes a new window will pop up.

- **Click** the button that says "Finish".

3. Restart Your Computer

Once you **Click** finish, a small window will pop up asking you if you would like to restart your computer.

- You can choose "Yes" to restart immediately, or you can
- choose "No, to restart a little later.
- To finish the installation **Click** the "Yes" button, and your computer will restart.
- Once it restarts, you will see the Kurzweil Icon on your desktop.

We will go over how to open and use Kurzweil in another tutorial.

Step 4 - Install the Firefox Add-on

Now that you have Kurzweil on your computer, I will help you install the Firefox Add-on so you can use Kurzweil to read web pages in the Firefox browser. If you do not have Firefox installed on your computer, please pause the video and go out to www.mozilla.org and download Firefox. Once you have Firefox downloaded, you can continue with the tutorial.

1. Locate the Kurzweil Icon

To install the Firefox Toolbar:

Locate the kurzweil icon which is a blue book with white stripes. This is usually found on your desktop.

- Once you have found the icon, double **Click** it...and the first thing it will ask you for is your username and password for kurzweil.
You should have been given this by Disability Services.

2. Login

Once you have typed in your username and password.

- **Click** the “Login” button.

3. Open the the web application

After Kurzweil opens

- Look at the right hand side of the top toolbar.
- Out of the options available, we want to **Click** the “Reference” tab.
- This will open a drop down menu.
- In the menu, **Click** the option that says, “Read the Web”
- After you **Click** this, a window will open up.
- When it opens, **Click** the “Yes” button.
- Another window will open asking if you authorize the installation.
- When you’re ready, **Click** the “Ok” button.
- Clicking this will automatically open Firefox.

4. Begin the Installation

In the top left hand corner, a window will pop up asking if you would like to Install the Add-on.

- **Click** the “Install” button.

5. Install the Add On and Restart Firefox

After you install the Add-on, a window will pop up again in the top left hand corner asking if you would like to restart Firefox.

- **Click** the “Restart Now” button.
- Firefox will then restart, and you will see a new toolbar at the top of the browser window. After you have installed the toolbar you must close out of Firefox in order to use it for the first time.

We will go over how to use this toolbar in another video. For now close Firefox.
