


## Instructions for Getting Your Passport to Adventure

If you already have a passport, check expiration date. What you'll need before submitting the application:

- 1. Obtain an official copy of your birth certificate from the Office of Vital Statistics in your state of birth. Photocopies aren't accepted.
- 2. Take two duplicate passport photos, available at Walgreens, BYU–I Photo Services, or the U.S. Post Office (check schedules online).
- 3. Have all application and processing fees (for most of you = \$165). Cost: \$130 (application fee) + \$35 (facility fee) + \$60 (if expedited) = \$165 \$225.
- 4. Have a valid driver's license, or other approved photo ID (see chart on next page) for identification and verification.
- 5. Application (Form DS-11) is available at <u>travel.state.gov</u> or the Madison County Clerk's office: 134 East Main Street, Suite 102, Rexburg.

continue to submit your physical, photo ID and a photocopy of the ID.

Timeframe: 8-11 weeks, 5-7 if expedited.





## Primary ID (submit one) Valid or expired, undamaged U.S. passport book or passport card In-state, fully-valid driver's license or enhanced driver's license with photo Certificate of Naturalization Certificate of Citizenship Government employee ID (city, county, state, or federal) U.S. military or military dependent ID Current (valid) foreign passport Matricula Consular (Mexican Consular ID) - commonly used by a parent of a U.S. citizen child applicant U.S. Permanent Resident Card (Green Card) - commonly used by a parent of a U.S. citizen child applicant Trusted Traveler IDs (including valid Global Entry, FAST, SENTRI, and NEXUS cards) Enhanced Tribal Cards and Native American tribal photo IDs Note: you may be asked to present an additional ID when presenting one of these three documents. 1) In-state, fullyvalid learner's permit with photo, 2) In-state, fully-valid non-driver ID with photo, or 3) temporary driver's license with photo. Notice on Digital Identification Documents: Some states now issue digital ID documents (also known as mobile driver's licenses or mobile IDs). We cannot accept these digital IDs when you apply for your U.S. passport. You must



Once you have your passport, make 3 color photocopies of your passport identification page.

- 1. Leave one copy at home.
- 2. Give one copy to a program director.
- 3. Carry the other copy with you (like in your luggage—but separately from your passport).
- This will facilitate replacement if your passport is lost or stolen.
- Always carry your actual passport on your person; do not stow it away in luggage.
